## ORDER

Magistrate Peter R. Palermo reaches 70 years of age on June 15, 1988. Title 28, U.S.C. § 631(d) provides that no Magistrate shall serve beyond seventy years of age without the approval of a majority vote of all the judges of the appointing court.

At the Meeting of the Judges of the Southern District of Florida held on May 11, 1988, a unanimous vote approved the continuation of the appointment of Magistrate Peter R. Palermo for a period of one year beyond his seventieth birthday, which occurs on June 15, 1988. Therefore, it is

ORDERED that Magistrate Peter R. Palermo shall continue his service with this court until June 15, 1989.
