ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER NO. 90-39

In re: 86-511-CR-Ryskamp

Pursuant to our blind random assignment system, the United States Attorney is to submit a Certificate of Trial Attorney simultaneously with the filing of a criminal indictment or information. This Certificate is used by the Clerk of Court to ascertain the category of each case for random assignment to the court. Judge Kenneth L. Ryskamp was randomly assigned 86-511-CR. This case, which was originally filed in Criminal Category IV, required two separate trials, the first lasting 75 days and qualifying as a Category V case, and the second lasting 38 days and fulfilling the requirements for a Category IV case.

Therefore, the Clerk of Court is hereby directed to credit Judge Ryskamp for the two trials, one in Category IV and one in Category V, and to make the appropriate credits upon the next refilling of the Criminal Categories IV and V wheels.
