IN RE: TRANSFER OF CASES TO MAGISTRATE JUDGE BARRY S. SELTZER

Magistrate Judge Barry S. Seltzer having been appointed as a magistrate judge for the Northern Division of this Court, and based upon the decisions reached by the Court regarding Judge Seltzer's duties, it is

ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED as follows:

- 1. All civil cases filed in the Northern Division will be stamped by the Clerk of Court with a magistrate's name at the time of filing. The civil cases will be assigned to magistrates on a random basis.
- 2. Any civil matter referred to a magistrate in the Northern Division will be accompanied by an Order of Reference from the District Judge which specifically designates the matters referred, and shall not simply refer the entire case to the magistrate for all future proceedings.
- 3. At the time a civil case is referred to a Northern Division magistrate, the District Judge shall send the magistrate a copy of the Order of Reference and the duplicate or "dummy" file. All pleadings filed as copies for judge shall be sent to the magistrate to whom the case has been referred.

5. Criminal cases filed in the Northern Division shall be assigned as follows: Judge Snow will handle all cases assigned to Judge Roettger and Judge Gonzalez; Judge Vitunac will handle all cases assigned to Judge Paine and the additional judge who is to be appointed for West Palm Beach, and Judge Seltzer will handle all cases assigned to Judge Zloch.

6. Each of the three magistrate judges in the North will handle four weeks of duty matters on a six week rotational basis. Magistrate Judge Barry S. Seltzer will rotate his term as duty judge by alternating between the west Palm Beach and Fort Lauderdale Courthouses. While on duty in the Fort Lauderdale Courthouse he will use chambers located on the fourth floor previously designated to the Court of International Trade.
