IN RE: JURY DUTY JUDGE ASSIGNMENT SCHEDULE, MIAMI

The following is an amended schedule of Jury Duty Judge assignments for the Southern District of Florida for January 1994 through December 1994. The functions of the Jury Duty Judge are as follows:

- 1. The Jury Duty Judge will consider and rule upon all written requests for excuses from complying with both grand and petit jury summonses throughout the District.
- 2. The Jury Duty Judge will be available between the hours of 8:30 9:30 a.m. on the first four mornings of each new two-week jury pool term.
- 3. After processing the jurors for attendance and orientation, the Jury Section will notify the Jury Duty Judge's chambers that those jurors who:
 - a. by reason of their inability to meet the qualification criteria specified by law (language, residency, conviction of a felony) or;
 - b. are requesting excusal because of an emergency which has arisen just prior to the reporting date, will be escorted to the Jury Duty Judge's Courtroom for the purpose of a hearing for these requests.
- 4. Upon hearing individual requests, the Jury Duty Judge will indicate his/her disposition of the request on the proposed order prepared by the Jury Section.
- 5. At the conclusion of the hearing, the Jury Clerk will escort the jurors back to the Assembly Room where the Judge's order will be executed.
