On August 3, 1993, following a request from the Court, Thomas E. "Ed" Davis, assistant regional administrator for GSA's Region Four in Atlanta advised GSA Washington the Region had withdrawn its support of artist Tom Otterness for artwork in Miami's Federal Justice Building. Furthermore, Mr. Davis requested the Court's assistance in (1) suggesting persons to serve on an artist selection committee, and (2) recommending notable Florida artists for further consideration by the committee.


It is now appropriate for the Court to appoint a committee of judges to represent the Southern District of Florida and act as the Court's liaison in all discussions and decisions with the General Services Administration under the Art-In-Architecture Program.

ORDERED, ADJUDGED, and DECREED the committee, to be designated the Federal Justice Building Artist Selection Committee be, and is hereby created with the following members:
