IN RE: PROCEDURE FOR FILLING POSITION OF FEDERAL PUBLIC DEFENDER, SOUTHERN DISTRICT OF FLORIDA

The Judicial Council of the Court of Appeals has delegated to the Southern District of Florida, the responsibility for developing a procedure for recruiting and interviewing applicants for the position of Federal Public Defender in the United States District Court for the Southern District of Florida, for the period of October 1, 1985 to October 1, 1989. Appointment of the Federal Public Defender will be made by the Court of Appeals after the Southern District of Florida recommends an applicant of applicants for appointment. The recommendations to the Court of Appeals must be received by Chief Judge Godbold not later than September 16, 1985. It is therefore

ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED:

- 1. That the position announcement for the position of Federal Public Defender, Southern District of Florida, attached hereto as exhibit 1, be disseminated to bar associations and given extensive publication in legal and other publications throughout the district, by the Court Executive.
- 2. That the Clerk of Court prepare sufficient application forms for dissemination upon request by interested parties, in accordance with the form appended hereto as exhibit 2.
- 3. That the deadline for receiving applications by those interested in applying is August 26, 1985, 5:00 p.m.

- 4. That the judges of this court shall then interview, either in panels or en banc, those individuals who have submitted applications for the position during the period August 27, 1985, until September 13, 1985.
- 5. That the court, en banc, shall thereafter discuss, determine and decide the individual, or individuals, to be recommended to the Court of Appeals for the Eleventh Judicial Circuit and make such recommendation not later than September 16, 1985.

POSITION ANNOUNCEMENT FEDERAL PUBLIC DEFENDER SOUTHERN DISTRICT OF FLORIDA

The current term of office of Theodore J. Sakowitz, Federal Public Defender for the Southern District of Florida expires on October 1, 1985. In keeping with its personnel policy for open selection, the U. S. District Court for the Southern District of Florida invites application from any qualified person for appointment as the Federal Public Defender for the Southern District of Florida. The appointment is for a four-year term and will be made by the U. S. Court of Appeals for the Eleventh Judicial Circuit. The annual salary is set by the Judicial Council of the Eleventh Circuit and presently will not exceed \$67,700.

The Federal Public Defender, functioning under authority of 18 U.S.C. §3006A(h)(2)(A) and the Criminal Justice Act Plan of this district, provides federal criminal defense services to individuals unable to afford counsel. In addition, the Federal Public Defender supervises a full-time staff of attorneys, administrative and clerical personnel.

An applicant must be a member in good standing in the bar of the state where he or she is admitted to practice. A minimum of five years criminal practice experience is required, preferably with significant federal criminal trial experience. An applicant must also possess the ability to effectively administer the office, have a reputation for integrity and have a commitment to the representation of those unable to afford counsel.

Neither the Federal Public Defender nor any Assistant Federal Public Defender may engage in the private practice of law.
