ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE


Based upon Humberto Aguilar's failure to comply with this Court's directive of September 27, 1985 specifically providing that:

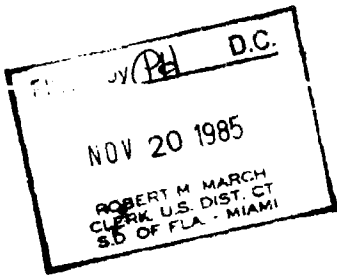
it is hereby,
