The Court Executive, Dyana L. Ortiz-Castro, is hereby designated as a non-voting member to render such assistance as may be required by the Panel in performing its functions.

The effective date of this appointment shall be this 28th day of August, 1986, and the Panel shall render its report and recommendation to the court within the ninety days following its appointment.
