

Until further notice, the Court Interpreter Program, in and for the Southern District of Florida, is hereby placed under the direct supervision and control of the Clerk of Court.

The Clerk shall exercise direct and complete control over the Interpreter Program for the Southern District of Florida which includes, but not limited to, the daily supervision of all full-time and contract interpreters; the screening and final recommendation to the Court for all potential hirees; the annual performance evaluation of all full-time interpreters; and the recommendation to the Court of any disciplinary and/or termination actions against any full-time or contract reporter. The Clerk is further responsible for the creation of such procedures and such systems he deems necessary to create and promote the highest possible standards for a Court Interpreter Program within the Federal Court System.
