Pursuant to the authority conferred by Title 28, United States Code, Section 631, et seq., and further, the authority granted in action taken by the Judicial Conference of the United States, it is,

ORDERED that TED EUGENE BANDSTRA be, and he is hereby, appointed as full-time United States Magistrate at Miami, Florida, at an annual salary as fixed by the Judicial Conference of the United States. It being further


ORDERED that said United States Magistrate shall commence performance of his duties on the 25th day of September, 1989, upon taking the oath or affirmation prescribed by Title 28, United States Code, Section 453 and 631(g), and shall hold and discharge the duties of his office for a term of eight years from the date of appointment subject to the provisions of Title 28, United States Code, Section 631(e), unless sooner relieved. It being further

ORDERED that the Clerk will cause certified copies of this order to be entered upon the record of this Court, and the District Executive shall forward a certified copy of this order and the

appropriate documents of appointment to the Director of the Administrative Office of the United States Courts.
