
In enacting Public Law 100-702, the Judicial Improvements and Access to Justice Act, Section 1021, Congress, on February 19, 1989, amended Title 28, United States Code, Section 89 to reconfigure the territorial jurisdiction of the Southern and Middle Districts of Florida.

Inasmuch as Collier, Hendry and Glades Counties were transferred from the Southern District to the Middle District consistent with this legislation, General Rule One of the Southern District of Florida's Local Rules is hereby amended to delete Collier County from the Miami venue, and Hendry and Glades Counties from the West Palm Beach venue.

This Administrative Order shall remain in effect until such time as the Southern District's Court Rules Committee acts upon this matter.
