
ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 91-47

**IN RE: CHANGE OF CRIMINAL
CASE CATEGORY**

Pursuant to the blind random assignment system, the United States Attorney is to submit a Certificate of Trial Attorney with the filing of a criminal indictment or information, indicating the length of time it will take for the trial of the case. The certificate is used by the Clerk of Court to ascertain the category of each case for random assignment to the Court. It appears that the trial time in the below listed case was less than the time listed on the certificate. Therefore, the Clerk of Court is hereby directed to effectuate the necessary category change for the following case.
