 - a. by reason of their inability to meet the qualification criteria specified by law (language, residency, conviction of a felony) or;
 - b. are requesting excusal because of an emergency which has arisen just prior to the reporting date, will be escorted to the Jury Duty Judge's Courtroom for the purpose of a hearing for these requests.
4. Upon hearing individual requests, the Jury Duty Judge will indicate his/her disposition of the request on the proposed order prepared by the Jury Section.


