



**IN RE: CONTINUATION OF
ONE-STEP SUMMONING AND
QUALIFICATION PROCEDURE**

On Monday, April 27, 1992, at a specially scheduled Meeting of the Judges of the Southern District of Florida, the matter of the continuation of the One-Step Juror Summoning and Qualification Procedure was presented. After assessment of the advantages of the One-Step process, it was, upon motion made, and unanimously carried, voted that the Southern District of Florida will continue to use the One-Step Summoning and Qualification Procedure as outlined in Title 28 U.S.C. § 1878(a), unless otherwise directed by Congress.
