

Pursuant to our blind random assignment system, Chief Judge Norman C. Roettger was assigned case no. 90-868, better known as the Yahweh case. Based on information extracted from his JS-10 reports, this case took 75 days of trial, with 444.5 trial hours. This averages to 5.92 trial hours per day, and fulfills the requirements for a criminal Category V case.

Therefore, the Clerk of Court is hereby directed to credit Chief Judge Norman C. Roettger, in criminal Category V, and remove his name from the Category V criminal case assignment wheel immediately.
