
Pursuant to Title 28, United States Code, Section 2077 (b), the Advisory Committee on Rules and Procedures of the Southern District of Florida recommended to the Court the revision of certain of the district's local rules. Following the Court's usual procedures, the committee presented to the Court their proposed new local rules (attached). The Court, having given notice pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 2071 (b) and Fed.R.Civ.P. 83, in the Miami, Broward, and West Palm Beach editions of the *Daily Business Review*, and having considered the committee's proposed new local rules along with any comments received thereon, does hereby:

ORDER, ADJUDGE, AND DECREE, that effective Monday, April 15, 1996, the United States District Court for the Southern District of Florida does hereby adopt pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 2071(f) and Fed.R.Civ.P. 83, the proposed new local rules submitted by the Advisory Committee on Rules and Procedures of the Southern District of Florida.

In accordance with 28 U.S.C. § 2071(d) and Fed.R.Civ.P. 83, the Clerk of Court will furnish a copy of the new local rules, together with a copy of this order, to the Eleventh Circuit Judicial Council and the Director of the Administrative Office of the United States Courts. Furthermore, the Clerk of Court will give appropriate public notice of the adoption of the new local rules and arrange for the public to obtain copies of the new rules.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED, that all previous issued administrative orders of the United States District Court for the Southern District of Florida, embracing declarations which are in conflict with the new local rules be held null and void.
