

Pursuant to the recommendation of the Executive Committee and as prescribed by the Judicial Conference of the United States under its authority to set fees pursuant to 28 U.S.C. Section 1914(b), effective December 19, 1996 the Court hereby establishes a new admissions fee of \$75.00.
