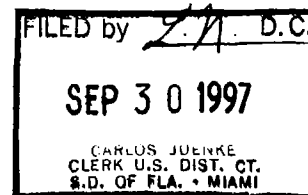

A review of the record in the causes marked on the attached computer list shows that the deposits required prior to issuance of a writ of garnishment remain in the Court registry. The causes have been adjudicated and the right to withdraw money is not in dispute. Such moneys have remained so deposited for at least five years unclaimed by the persons entitled thereto.

It is further noted that any moneys deposited with the U. S. Treasury as unclaimed are available for immediate disbursement by this office upon further Court order.

It is therefore requested that the Clerk be directed to cause said moneys, as shown in the current balance column, to be deposited in the Treasury in the name and to the credit of the United States.


