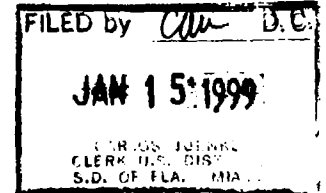




IN RE: CHANGE OF CRIMINAL CASE
