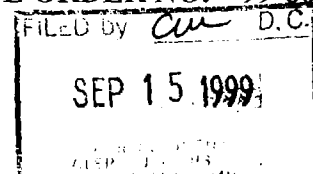


ORDER OF SUSPENSION

It has been shown to the Court that the Supreme Court of Florida has automatically suspended the above-named attorney from practicing law in Florida effective 30 days following a May 21, 1999 court order. Pursuant to the Rules Governing Attorney Discipline, United States District Court, Southern District of Florida, it is ORDERED that said attorney be automatically suspended from practice in this court effective 30 days following the Supreme Court of Florida May 21, 1999 court order.
