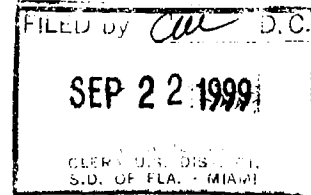


**DESIGNATION OF BANKRUPTCY JUDGE
ROBERT A. MARK AS CHIEF BANKRUPTCY JUDGE**



Pursuant to Administrative Order 98-40 which implemented a set term for the Chief Bankruptcy Judge in the Southern District of Florida with the same terms and conditions as apply to Chief District Judges, and pursuant to Title 28 U.S.C. § 136(a)(3)(C) which states that "No district judge may serve or act as chief judge of the district after attaining the age of seventy years . . ." and in light of Chief Bankruptcy Judge A. Jay Cristol reaching his seventieth birthday on September 25, 1999, the Court, expressing full faith and confidence in The Honorable Robert A. Mark, does hereby

ORDER, ADJUDGE and DECREE that Bankruptcy Judge Robert A. Mark be, and he is hereby, designated as Chief Bankruptcy Judge of the United States Bankruptcy Court, Southern District of Florida, effective September 25, 1999 until further order of the Court.
