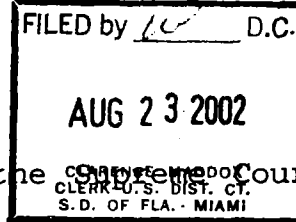

ORDER OF DISBARMENT


