

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 2005-14

ORDER OF SUSPENSION



It has been shown to the Court that the Supreme Court of Florida has suspended the above-named attorney from practicing law in Florida for three (3) years, effective, nunc pro tunc, March 5, 2003, following an April 22, 2004, order. On October 29, 2004, Mr. Olds was served by mail with an Order to Show Cause why this Court should not impose the same discipline, accompanied by the Supreme Court of Florida's Order of Suspension. As of the date of this Order, more than 90 days have passed with no response from Mr. Olds. Pursuant to the Rules Governing Attorney Discipline, United States District Court, Southern District of Florida, it is ORDERED that said attorney be suspended from practice in this Court, effective March 5, 2003.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED by this Court that said attorney advise the Clerk of the Court of all pending cases before this Court in which he is counsel or co-counsel of record.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED by this Court that the Clerk of Court mail Warner Smith Olds a copy of this Order of Suspension.
