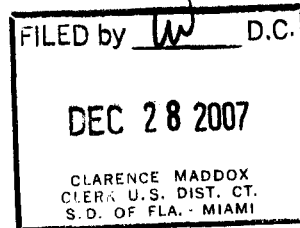

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 2007- 71

**IN RE:
AMENDMENT TO COURT OPERATIONS
SCHEDULE DURING HOLIDAYS**




Administrative Order 2007-60 established a court operations and closure schedule for the various holidays occurring in November and December of this year. That Order contemplated the operation of the Court with minimal staffing on New Years Eve, Monday, December 31st. In view of the decision by many judges to close their chambers on Monday, December 31st, and the fact that the Administrative Office of the U. S. Courts is also closing on that date, it is hereby

ORDERED and ADJUDGED that the Courts of the Southern District of Florida will be closed on Monday, December 31, 2007, for the New Year's Eve holiday.

It is further **ORDERED and ADJUDGED** that in all other respects, Administrative Order 2007-60 will remain in full force and effect, and in particular, it is noted that the rules regarding judicial emergencies will continue to apply.
