ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 2012-43

IN RE: REASSIGNMENT OF TOUSA
BANKRUPTCY APPEALS

Due to District Judge Adalberto Jordan's appointment to the Eleventh Circuit Court of Appeals and District Judge Alan Gold's taking senior status and being no longer on the bankruptcy wheel, it is

ORDERED that effective immediately, the TOUSA bankruptcy cases assigned to Judge Jordan, Case Nos. 10-60018 and 10-61681, and the TOUSA bankruptcy cases assigned to Judge Gold, Case Nos. 10-60017, 10-61478, 10-62032, and 10-62037, shall be consolidated before one judge. It is

FURTHER ORDERED that the Clerk of Court shall randomly assign the consolidated cases to one District Judge on the bankruptcy wheel. However, that District Judge shall receive credit for six cases when they are officially open as some have been stayed pending appeal and others await a mandate from the Eleventh Circuit Court of Appeals. It is

FURTHER ORDERED that the Clerk's Office will make a notation on the docket of each case reflecting the fact that the case has been transferred upon the authority of this Administrative Order, and each counsel of record will receive notification through the CM/ECF procedures or by mail. Because this Administrative Order is available for public viewing on the Court's website, a copy of this Administrative Order need not be docketed in each case.
