ORDER FOR PLACEMENT ON THE INACTIVE LIST FOR INCAPACITY

The Supreme Court of Florida has entered an Order dated September 3, 2013, classifying Terence Millard Brown as an inactive member pursuant to Rule 3-7.13 of the Rules Regulating The Florida Bar. See *The Florida Bar v. Brown*, 123 So.3d 560 (Fla. Sept. 3, 2013). That Order was predicated on a Petition for Placement of Attorney on the Inactive List following Brown's filing of a Waiver of Probable Cause Finding for such placement due to incapacity.

Rule 3 of the Special Rules Governing the Admission and Practice of Attorneys, Local Rules of the United States District Court for the Southern District of Florida, requires that "[t]o remain an attorney in good standing of the bar of this Court, each member must remain an active attorney in good standing of The Florida Bar. . . . Attorneys who are not in good standing of the bar of this Court may not practice before the Court."


Under these circumstances, by consenting to be placed on inactive status with The Florida Bar, an Order to Show Cause is unnecessary for this attorney to be similarly treated as inactive with this Court. Given this background, pursuant to Rule 3 and the Court's inherent power to regulate membership in its bar for the protection of the public interest, see *Chambers v. NASCO, Inc.*, 501 U.S. 32, 43 (1991) ("[A] federal court has the power to control admission to its bar and to discipline attorneys who appear before it."),

IT IS ORDERED that said attorney be removed from this Court's roster of attorneys eligible to practice before this Court and be placed on inactive status. The Clerk of Court shall strike this attorney from the roll of attorneys eligible to practice in the United States District Court

for the Southern District of Florida, and shall also immediately revoke the attorney's CM/ECF password.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED by this Court that said attorney advise the Clerk of Court of all pending cases before this Court in which he is counsel or co-counsel of record.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED by this Court that the Clerk of Court attempt to serve by certified mail a copy of this Order for Placement on the Inactive List for Incapacity upon the attorney at his court record address.
