ORDER ON PETITION FOR REINSTATEMENT

THIS CAUSE is before the Court on attorney Bradford L. Stewart's Petition for Reinstatement as a member of the Bar of this Court. Mr. Stewart was reciprocally disciplined by this Court based upon an Order of Suspension by the Supreme Court of Florida. *See The Florida Bar v. Stewart*, No. SC17-101, 2017 WL 629429 (Fla. Feb. 16, 2017). On June 21, 2017, Mr. Stewart filed a Petition for Reinstatement with The Florida Bar. On October 11, 2017, after consideration of a report of the referee, the Supreme Court of Florida issued an Order of Reinstatement reinstating Mr. Stewart as a member in good standing with The Florida Bar. *See The Florida Bar re Stewart*, No. SC17-1181, 2017 WL 4533747 (Fla. Oct. 11, 2017).

Pursuant to Rule 12(c) of this Court's Rules Governing the Admission, Practice, Peer Review, and Discipline of Attorneys, upon consideration of the Petition, attachments to the Petition, and being otherwise fully advised in the matter, the Court finds that Mr. Stewart qualifies for reinstatement to this Court's Bar. Accordingly, this Court GRANTS Mr. Stewart's Petition for Reinstatement and orders that he be reinstated as a member in good standing to the Bar of this Court.
