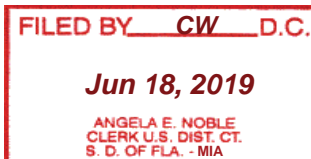

**IN RE: THIRD AMENDED DUTY JUDGE
ASSIGNMENT SCHEDULE, FORT LAUDERDALE**



Due to the confirmation of United States District Judge Rodney Smith, the Court amends the Duty Judge Assignment Schedule for Fort Lauderdale set forth in Administrative Order 2019-36. Pursuant to the Court's Internal Operating Procedures, IOP 8.00.00 entitled "Duty Judge," the following is a **revised** schedule for July 2019 through December 2019, as to the Duty Judge for Fort Lauderdale:

The Duty Judge should be present in the district and available for handling Duty Judge matters at all times during the month assigned. If it is necessary for the Duty Judge to be out of the district for a short period of time during the assignment month, it is the Duty Judge's responsibility to make arrangements with another Judge to handle all Duty Judge matters arising during the brief absence, and to notify the Chief Judge and Clerk of Court.

The Duty Judge's functions are consistent with the Court's Internal Operating Procedures, IOP 8.01.00.
