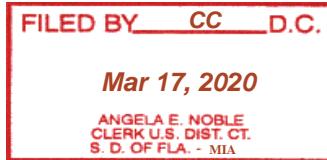

ORDER ON PETITION FOR REINSTATEMENT

THIS CAUSE is before the Court on attorney Gilberto E. Sanchez's Petition for Reinstatement as a member of the Bar of this Court. Sanchez was reciprocally disciplined by this Court based upon an Order of Suspension by the Supreme Court of Florida. See Administrative Order 2016-22 and *The Florida Bar v. Sanchez*, No. SC16-222, 2016 WL 745541 (Fla. Feb. 25, 2016). On August 11, 2017, Sanchez filed a Petition for Reinstatement with The Florida Bar. After consideration of an uncontested report of the referee and Joint Stipulation for Reinstatement, the Supreme Court of Florida issued an Order of Reinstatement on December 20, 2017, reinstating Sanchez as a member in good standing with The Florida Bar. See *The Florida Bar RE: Sanchez*, No. SC17-1515, 2017 WL 6523452 (Fla. Dec. 20, 2017).

Pursuant to Rule 12(c) of this Court's Rules Governing the Admission, Practice, Peer Review, and Discipline of Attorneys, upon consideration of the Petition, attachments to the Petition, and being otherwise fully advised in the matter, the Court finds that Sanchez qualifies for reinstatement to this Court's Bar. Accordingly, this Court GRANTS Sanchez's Petition for Reinstatement and orders that he be reinstated as a member in good standing to the Bar of this Court.
