

## **ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 2020-31**

## IN RE: APPOINTMENT OF FEDERAL MAGISTRATE JUDGE MERIT SELECTION PANEL REGARDING UPCOMING REAPPOINTMENT OF MAGISTRATE JUDGE PATRICK M. HUNT

The Panel will meet as necessary, and after consideration of comments and feedback obtained, will make their recommendation to the Court by July 31, 2020.

All Panel members have been advised in writing of the restriction set forth in § 420.30.20(d) of the Regulations of the Judicial Conference of the United States Establishing Standards and Procedures for the Appointment and Reappointment of United States Magistrate Judges.

This Federal Magistrate Judge Merit Selection Panel and the term of each member shall expire on October 31, 2020, unless otherwise extended or modified by order of this Court.
