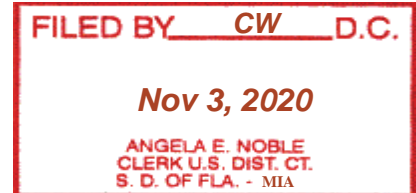

The Panel will meet as necessary, and after consideration of comments and feedback obtained, will make their recommendation to the Court by January 22, 2021.

This Federal Magistrate Judge Merit Selection Panel and the term of each member shall expire on August 31, 2021, unless otherwise extended or modified by order of this Court.
